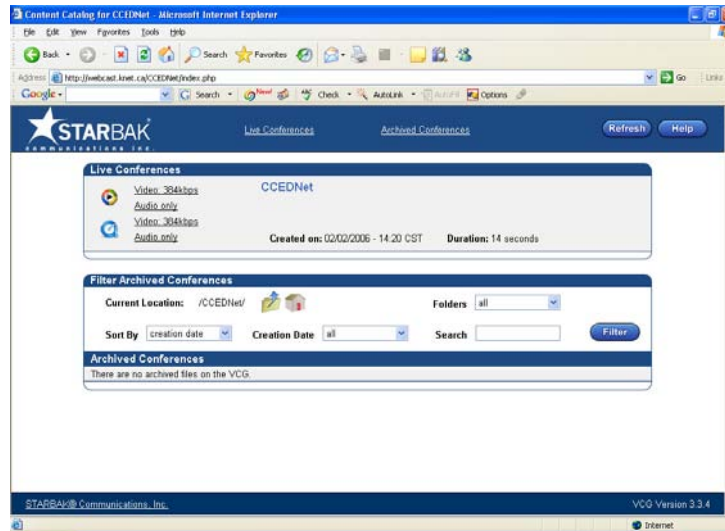


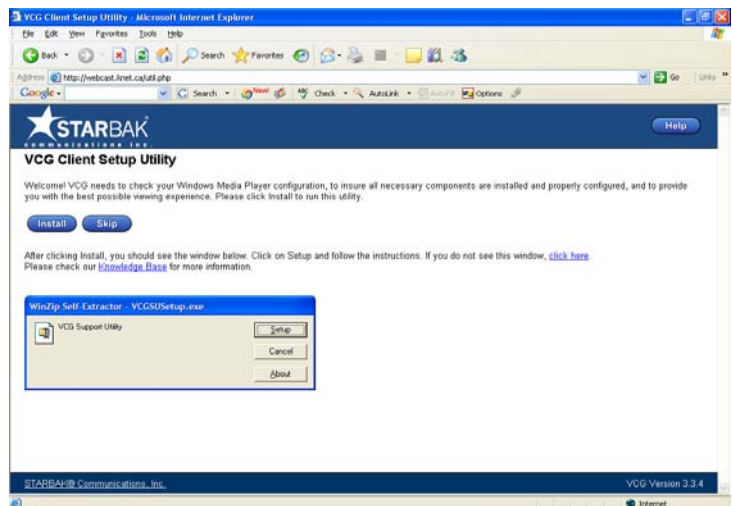
## How to Access the On-Line Streaming From K-Net's Web Streaming Service.

1. Web cast URL ... <http://webcast.knet.ca/events/>

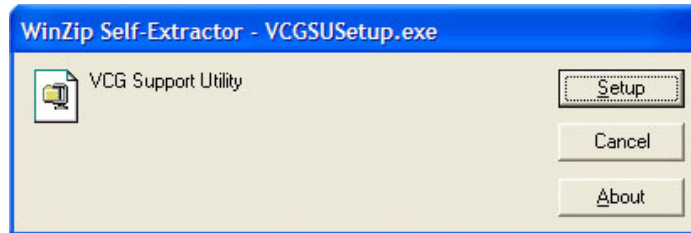


2. There are two areas in the above window, LIVE and ARCHIVED conferences. In the LIVE CONFERENCES you will see any events that are being streamed live on the internet. The second is for archived events that have been saved for easy access after the live event.
3. Look under **LIVE CONFERENCES** for the session that is being webcast live. Select whether you wish to view it using Windows Media or Quicktime. Carefully follow the steps completing all the proper installations so you can watch the webcast.

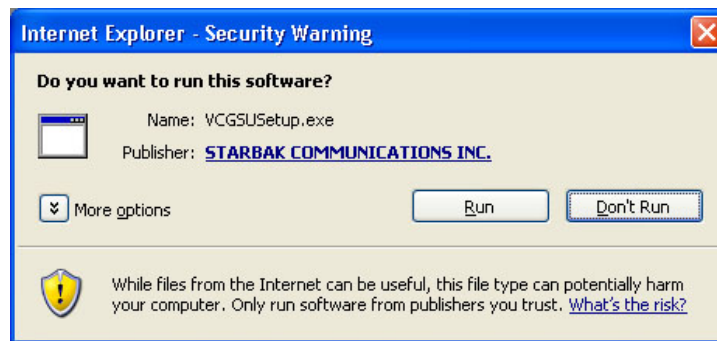
You should now see a screen like this:



4. From here you will have to install a plug-in from the webcast server in order to watch the webcast. You will only need to do this once but it needs to be done properly or the webcast will not be displayed properly. Choose “**install**”, and then you should be able to choose “setup”



the plug-in will now install automatically. If you see the security warning as shown below, please choose “run”.



5. At this point you may notice a bar at the top of your browser window, that advises you to click on the bar to allow “activex controls”. This is normal. Just click on the bar to allow this, and also allow pop-ups. 6. Your streamed event should now available. If the webcast does not appear then an installation step got missed and you will have to go to Step 7.
